# **Coronavirus Pandemic Discussion |**

During the March 18, 2020 Elk Island Catholic Schools Board of Trustee monthly meeting, a majority of the agenda was directed to the immediate plans in light of the recent public health crisis that presents itself across the globe. Discussion points centered on:

• the recent move to cancel all classes from the Minister of Education on Sunday, March 15th, 2020

• next steps needed for the continuation of educational programming throughout the division and a move towards online learning.

• immediate needs in our schools for students: scheduling and organizing the cleaning out of student desks/lockers with textbooks and necessary tools for students to now have at home in order to continue their programming.

In parallel with the educational and regular functioning of the school division, planning is taking place on keeping the health and wellness of our staff within schools and facilities as a necessary priority setting up process for communications in a variety of methods including:

- 1. Daily superintendent messages to all staff email and video

Each year, school boards are required to submit a three-year capital plan to Alberta Education. This plan provides project justification and supportability and demonstrates overall planning and management, communicate local priorities, provide project definitions for budget and scope and demonstrate that all options for the accommodation of students has been explored and considered.

### Highlights of the EICS 2021-2024 Capital Plan include:

Priority One: New Catholic High School in Camrose

**Priority Two:** Replacement school for Our Lady of Angels Catholic School in Fort Saskatchewan

**Priority Three:** Modernization and addition of École Père Kenneth Kearns Catholic Elementary School
