INSTRUCTIONAL TIME: GRADES 1 to 12

Background

Under the direction of the Superintendent, an instructional week that meets the requirements of Alberta Education and the Division shall be established.

Procedures

- 1. Principals shall ensure that sufficient time is provided for students to meet the expectations of Alberta Education as well as Religious Education outcomes.
- 2. Several methods of scheduling may be used in order to:
 - 2.1. Meet the diverse needs, abilities and interests of students;
 - 2.2. Ensure a program that balances the activities for the students; and
 - 2.3. Accommodate school-wide sharing of space and resources.
- 3. At the beginning of the school year, the Principal shall forward copies of timetables to the Superintendent or designate.
- 4. Principals shall take into consideration the bus schedules established for all students within the Division when determining school starting and closing times.
