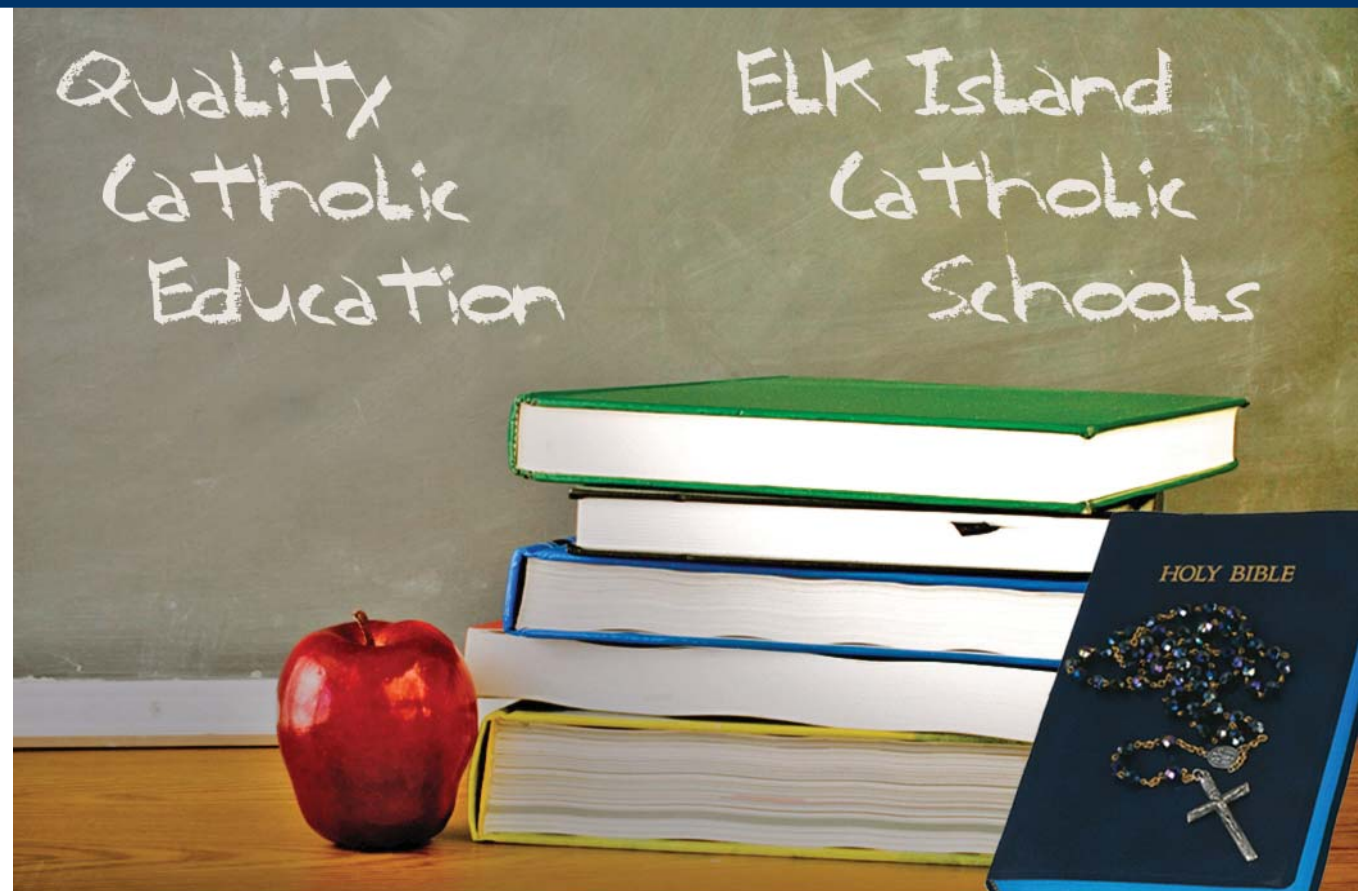

Our School Programs

EICS offers quality, Catholic education programming for grades Kindergarten to 12. Our programs provide students with the opportunity to become valuable community members - before and after graduation. The following are only some of the programs we offer:

French Immersion is designed for children who do not speak French at home. It provides students with the ability to live, learn and work in both French and English and creates the foundation for the exploration of other languages.

French Immersion is offered at École Our Lady of Perpetual Help School for Grades K-9 and at Archbishop Jordan Catholic High School for Grades 10-12.

Ukrainian Bilingual Program follows the Alberta Program of Studies in all subject areas. It is taught through Ukrainian Language Arts and is integrated into other subject areas as well. Technology, Computer Skills, and Ukrainian Cultural Programs are incorporated into the curriculum.

The Ukrainian Program is designed for students who have no Ukrainian experience or background. The Program allows students to explore and understand Ukrainian culture and heritage.

Our Ukrainian Program is offered at Father Kenneth Kearns Catholic School for Grades K-6; Jean Vanier Catholic School for Grades 7-9; and Archbishop Jordan Catholic High School for Grades 10-11.

Spanish Language Training is offered at École Our Lady of Perpetual Help School beginning in Grade 4.

Career and Technology Studies (CTS)

EICS provides state-of-the-art Career and Technology labs where students are given a hands-on opportunity to explore subjects like Food, Art, Construction, Fabrication, Video and Communications Technologies.

EICS Sports Program is a combined option class and physical education class. It's open to any Grade 7-8 student at Our Lady of the Angels Catholic School. In addition to the regular physical education curriculum, the program includes hockey, golf, judo, indoor soccer, yoga, water sports, triathlon, taekwondo, and career and wellness.

Student Services

EICS offers a wide-variety of services to all students - from accessing technology, assistance, and support to providing guidance and special programming.

Comprehensive School Guidance and Counselling

programs are available at all schools within our Division. School counsellors play an important role in our schools by providing developmental guidance instruction, responsive services, and individual student planning. They are members of the Critical Response Teams, which are available to respond to any emergency situation that may arise. Referrals for school counselling can be initiated by students, parents or teachers.

Special Education Programming

is available at all schools throughout our Division in order to help students with special needs, including those students with a range of disabilities, reach their full potential and become valuable community members.

We offer individualized programs that emphasize a range of interventions depending on the student's needs. Interventions and program planning aim to help maintain the student in an inclusive setting.



Brighter Beginnings

is a special early intervention program offered by EICS for three to five year olds who qualify for Program Unit Funding.

LifeSkills, a special program for junior and senior high school students with developmental disabilities, is also offered by EICS.

Psychological Services

are available throughout the Division. These important services provide direct support to school staff and parents in identifying and assisting students who have special needs.
