At the 2009 Annual General Meeting (November 20-22), the Alberta Catholic School Trustees' Association elected Sandra Bannard, of St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Schools, as the association's new President. Bannard was the former ACSTA Vice-President. Tony Sykora, of Elk Island Catholic Schools, was elected as the new Vice-President of the ACSTA. Former ACSTA President Ted Paszek will now move to the position of Past-President.
