- Brighter Beginnings is for children between the ages of 2 $1\!/\!_2$ to 5 $1\!/\!_2$ years who may have a severe and/or moderate delay in one or more developmental areas, such as speech and language, fine and gross motor, or a medical condition.
- Children with mild/moderate special needs, or who are gifted and talented, are eligible to receive special education services and programming at 3 1/2 years of age.
- Children attend their community school for their kindergarten program, which is consistent with EICS' Inclusive Education practices.
