PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS

Background

No individual or organization shall be admitted to a school to promote the sale of goods, services, or investments unless having prior approval from the Superintendent.

Procedures

- 1. Only those public solicitations that have received approval through a letter of authorization from the Superintendent may take place within or through the schools.
- 2. No collection shall be taken up or subscription solicited by schools, except for legitimate school activities, unless by the express permission of the Superintendent.
- 3. No contest other than those sponsored by groups connected with the school will be permitted or conducted without the approval of the Superintendent. Such approval must be granted annually.
- 4. Names, addresses and personal information of students and staff members shall not be released or furnished to unauthorized persons.
