SCHOOL-OWNED VEHICLES

Background

Schools may purchase and maintain school buses or vans to transport students or staff on field trips, athletic competitions or other school-related activities. This service is designed to facilitate student participation in extra-curricular and co-curricular activities in a cost efficient manner.

Procedures

- 1. All school owned vehicles purchased for transporting students after September 1, 2008 must meet current CSA crash safety standards.
- 2. Principals are required to consult with the Superintendent or designate prior to purchasing any school owned vehicles.
- Schools are prohibited from owning or renting fifteen (15) passenger vans.
- 4. The driver is required to have the correct license to operate the vehicle and must operate the vehicle in accordance with the Traffic Safety Act.
- The driver will inspect the vehicle before each use (minimum once per day). A pretrip log sheet must be used to record these inspections. All deficiencies must be reported immediately.
- 6. The Passenger load limit in the vehicle will be strictly enforced.
- 7. If the vehicle is equipped with seat belts, the driver is responsible for ensuring that all passengers are correctly utilizing these seat belts.
