#### Age Requirement

Children must be **five years of age on or before December 31** in the year they wish to register for Kindergarten (birth certificate required at registration).

## **Brighter Beginnings**

Brighter Beginnings is staffed by a team of dedicated, caring professionals who are passionate about celebrating and nurturing the skills of all children. This early intervention program is tailored to meet the individual needs of children between 2<sup>1/2</sup> to 5<sup>1/2</sup> years of age who may have a severe/moderate delay in one or more developmental areas; communication (speech and Language concerns), fine and gross motor skills or a medical condition. Brighter Beginnings is offered at Madonna Catholic School - 15 Main Boulevard, Sherwood Park.

Programming includes: Early Literacy, Natural Teaching Strategies, Assistive Technology, Whole Language, Faith Development and Family Oriented Programs. Program Unit Funding is available through Alberta Education and is available for up to three years. Children attend their community school for Kindergarten, which is consistent with EICS' *Inclusive Education* Practices.
