EICS 2020 School Re-Entry Planning

EICS is preparing for the next school year beginning in September 2020 with the safety of students, staff and families at the forefront of our minds and plans. This has been our main priority since March of 2020 and will continue to be as we move forward.

Minister LaGrange indicated in her May announcement that they will have a final decision on which scenario School Board's will operate under by August 1, 2020. It is important to note that any return to school will be done so under the guidance and direction from Alberta's Chief Medical Officer of Health and Alberta Education.

What we can share with you now as a division, is that Administration and staff within EICS are creating comprehensive plans for each scenario, guided by Alberta Education's 2020-2021 School Re-Entry Plan, and its supporting documents regarding Scenarios' 1 and 2.

Over the Summer, once the August 1st decision is made, we will be communicating with all EICS families and sharing the specifics to our plans via email and the EICS main website. We know, as you do, that the best place for our students to learn is in a classroom with their peers, supported by an entire school community. It is there that they receive an outstanding educational experience, and it is what we are all hoping for heading into the next school year, as we plan for all eventualities.

EICS Board of Trustees Celebrates 2020 Grads

All four high school graduations in the division did an amazing job of acknowledging their graduates within the context of the pandemic and all the public health restrictions. Celebrations were certainly different in 2020, but very heartfelt and appreciated by the students and their families. Examples of celebrations included:

- Each school had a virtual graduation mass
- OLMP, SAB, St. Mary's and ABJ all had the ability to do a drive thru graduation celebration of some capacity or virtual celebration and each school had a car parade in which our trustees were invited to participate in.
- Strathcona County worked in collaboration with EICS and EIPS to honour the three high schools and continuing education centres in Strathcona County by having the names of all County graduates scrolling on the electronic signs at Millenium Place; Broadmoor Park and through the Chamber of Commerce sign on Wye Road.
- EICS Board of Trustees purchased ½ page colour ads in all community newspapers to give blessings and congratulations to all of our graduates. These ads are running the week of June 22 in Sherwood Park and Fort Saskatchewan; June 25 in the Camrose Booster and June 25 in the Vegreville Advertiser to coincide with all of the papers' graduation special theme.
