STUDENT SAFETY PATROLS

Background

The Division recognizes the importance of encouraging the students of its schools and the drivers of vehicles in the school community to exercise caution and sound safety practices. Principals are, therefore, encouraged to co-operate with community stakeholders in establishing student safety patrols where circumstances warrant.

Procedures

- 1. Each Principal is responsible for determining the need for, establishment and maintenance of a School Safety Patrol.
- 2. The Principal shall inform the Superintendent or designate of the establishment a School Safety Patrol for insurance purposes.
- 3. It is expected that all student participants receive prior training.
