CATHOLIC SCHOOLS CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT PROCESS

Background

Collaborative reviews involving educational community stakeholders will be conducted to assist schools in a process of gathering, analyzing and synthesizing information to assist in the creation of a strategic plan that continues to move and improve the school in all areas of learning within our culture of faith.

Procedures

- 1. The Superintendent is responsible for the review of schools depending on need and the availability of resources.
- 2. The process may include a review of stakeholder satisfaction, student success, staff competence, facility adequacy, program quality, support services or any other factor deemed necessary.
- 3. Focus areas for the process will be designed through a collaborative of administration, staff, parents, and other partners and stakeholders (Appendix).
- 4. The Principal shall, within sixty (60) calendar days of the receipt of the final report, provide a written action plan which effectively addresses the recommendations contained in the report. The Superintendent or designate shall set the format for the action plans.
