New Catholic High School for Camrose



Alberta's government is providing \$268 million for school construction in the province, including a new high school for Elk Island Catholic Schools in Camrose.

"As you can imagine, as a board and division, we are thrilled with the announcement from Alberta Education Minister Adrianna LaGrange and Alberta Infrastructure Minister Prasad Panda that our request for a new high school Camrose will become a reality," expressed EICS Board Chair Ted Paszek. "This has been at the top of our capital planning requests for a number of years and we want to thank the Alberta Government for hearing our voice on this important issue and we look forward to working with them on this exciting project."

On March 12th, 2021 Board Chair Ted Paszek, Trustee Ron Baier and Superintendent Shawn Haggarty were joined by MLA Jackie Lovely, Camrose Mayor Norm Mayer, Camrose City Councillors Kevin Hycha and Max Lindstrand, St. Frances Xavier Parish Priest Fr.
