# **2026-2029** Capital **Plan**

## **Short Term Recommendations (1 - 3 years)**

Fort Saskatchewan Zone 2: 2 to 1 Consolidation

As per the outcome of a value scoping session in early 2024, the Division requests design and construction funding for a new K-4 school on a new school site in Fort Saskatchewan. The division also requests demolition funding for Our Lady of the Angels School; St. John XXIII will become surplus for the division.

Sherwood Park Zone 1: 2 to 1 Consolidation

Pre-planning funds are requested for value scoping and public engagement to explore options aimed at reducing excess capacity in Zone 1, increasing utilization, and improving learning environments

## Vegreville Zone 5: 2 to 1 Consolidation

Funding to explore a right-sizing option involving a K-12 consolidation in either St. Martin's or St. Mary's School. Pre-planning funds requested for value scoping and public engagement. Planning and design funds are also requested to develop the best option.
