

## **PUBLIC SOLICITATIONS**

### **Background**

No individual or organization shall be admitted to a school to promote the sale of goods, services, or investments unless having prior approval from the Superintendent.

### **Procedures**

1. Only those public solicitations that have received approval through a letter of authorization from the Superintendent may take place within or through the schools.
2. No collection shall be taken up or subscription solicited by schools, except for legitimate school activities, unless by the express permission of the Superintendent.
3. No contest other than those sponsored by groups connected with the school will be permitted or conducted without the approval of the Superintendent. Such approval must be granted annually.
4. Names, addresses and personal information of students and staff members shall not be released or furnished to unauthorized persons.
